

# Grantsburg Fair Tractor Pull Rules 2006

## ANTIQUUE;

## WEIGHT CLASSES

Stock RPMS 4,500 6,500

Speed Limit - 4 miles per hour

Maximum Tire Size - 15.5-38

1942 or older

Top 3 pullers will have RPMS checked

Stock Block - No Block Spacers

Governor Required

## FARM STOCK;

## WEIGHT CLASSES

Stock RPMS 3,500 5,000 7,000 9,000

Speed limit - 4 miles per hour 12,000 15,000 2 Wheel Drive

Stock block 15,000 4 Wheel Drive

Factory turbos allowed 18,000 (All)

Governor required 12,000 No Speed Limit

No Speed limit on 15,000 pounds & up

Maximum Tire Size; 3,500 to 5,000 - 16.9-38

“ “ “ 7,000 to 9,000 - 18.4-38

“ “ “ 12,000 & up - No Size limit

## HOBBY STOCK;

## WEIGHT CLASSES

No RPM limit 3,500 5,000 7,000 9,000 12,000

No speed limit

Stock appearing carburetors;

Stock appearing manifolds, injector pumps & heads

Turbos allowed only on 12,000 class

Power blocks allowed

Wheelie bars required for safety

Safety blankets only plate required around clutch & flywheel

John Deere 2 cylinders must have cross bolt on flywheel

Breakaway switch required

Gas, Propane, or Diesel Fuel - No Nitrous or Oxidizers. One Fuel per tractor

No adapter plates

## OPEN CLASS;

## WEIGHT CLASSES

Must have wheelie bars 6,200 7,500 9,000

Breakaway switch & deadman throttle required

Tractor appearing block

Scatter blanket or 1/4" steel plate required around clutch & flywheel

Alcohol, Gas, Propane or Diesel Fuel - No Nitrous

Naturally aspirated carburetor tractors allowed if three or more

Exhaust pipe must be cross bolted

Rollover protection **MUST** support the weight of the tractor

Helmet and full fire suit are **MANDATORY**

## MODIFIED

## WEIGHT CLASSES

All safety rules apply 5,200 7,200

5,200 Single Engine, No Nitrous

1. All engine fans must be factory or shrouded with steel 1/16" or thicker. All transmissions and clutch housings must be covered. All turbos not under hood must be completely shrouded 1/16" or thicker except for an inlet and exhaust pipe.

2. No part of tractor may interfere with sled during pull. Front weight frame or weights may not extend more than 11' from center of rear axle. All weights must be safely secured to the tractor and cannot be on three point arms.
3. Only one fuel per tractor.
4. All ignition engines must have a kill switch in working order within easy reach of the driver.
5. All exhaust must be factory or discharged vertically upward above the highest point of the tractor. No rain caps or curved exhaust pipes on Hobby, Open or Modified Classes.
6. All classes will use standard draw bar rules. Minimum draw bar length - 18" from the center of rear wheel to point of hook measured horizontally. Draw bar must be stationary in all directions. Maximum drawbar height of 20" - hitch point to ground. Pull point must be no more than 1 1/2" from back edge of hitching device. No bracing of draw bar to three point or top link.
7. Operator must remain seated during the pull and have complete control of the tractor at all times. All tractors must have working rear brakes.
8. Tractors may be down shifted during the pull provided that the forward motion is maintained. The use of torque amplifiers and power shift is allowed.
9. **No consumption of alcoholic beverages or drugs in the pit area before or during the contest. If any one judge believes any driver to be a potential safety hazard, that driver will be disqualified with no refund of entry fee.**
10. Tractor and skid must remain within boundaries of course.
11. Contest is to be governed by judges with all decisions final. Judges have the right to stop and disqualify at any time with no refund of entry fees.
12. Duals allowed in Farm Stock Classes only. They must meet size requirements. No cut tires except in Open & Hobby Classes.
13. Any parts or equipment falling off the tractor will disqualify the pull.
14. Tractor entry fee will include the driver only. Extra pit passes will be available for \$10.
15. One pull per tractor except open, hobby & modified classes. Must pull next weight in same class.
16. Must have three tractors in class to receive trophies.
17. In Antique and Farm Stock Classes, the top three pullers will have RPMS checked at end of track. Driver must remain with tractor.
18. All weight classes are with driver, no extra weight allowed; 5,000# means 5,000#, etc.
19. Antique and Farm Stock Classes must have working PTO unless factory equipped without.
20. Antique and Farm Stock Classes throttles must be against throttle stop at maximum RPM.
21. All under age drivers must have parents written, notarized permission. Parents assume all responsibility. Subject to Judges approval.
22. No first puller repull option.
23. Sportsmanship Rule; Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. It will result in a year and one week suspension.

**Pre-registration Entry Fee; \$20 includes Tractor & Driver; Pre-registration deadline is August 18, 2006. Extra pit passes will be \$10, and will be available for purchase at the registration area. Entry fee after August 20th will be \$25.00.**

**Payout Schedule; Single entry in any class pays \$25. Three entries in any class pays out 2 places. More than 4 entries will pay 4 places with plaques for 3 places.**

**Antiques and smaller farm classes will start promptly at 6 PM, please be ready!!!**
